#### **CONDITIONS**

The event will be conducted under the jurisdiction of the Ryder Cup Europe LLP, European Golf Association and the PGA of America.

The 2012 European Ryder Cup Junior Match Team will consist of 12 players, all of whom must be citizens of member nations of the European Golf Association. 4 players (2 girls and 2 boys) will be under the age of 16 on 1 January 2012. 8 players (4 girls and 4 boys) will be under the age of 18 on 1 January 2012.

Team members will have to arrange for travel from home to London Heathrow Airport (LHR) on the morning of 20 September, and from LHR to home on 1 October. In the past, each team member's golf federation or golf union has paid for travel costs to and from LHR.

Team members are to ensure they arrive to meet Ryder Cup Europe LLP representatives at LHR Terminal 5 (T5) at 13.00 on 20 September 2012.

The flight details to Chicago from Heathrow and the return flights are:

- 20 Sept. BA 297: Departs LHR T5, 15:35 Arrives IL (ORD) 17:55 local time.
- 30 Sept. BA 296: Departs IL (ORD) 20:35 Arrives LHR T5, 10:00 local time 1 Oct.



#### **CONDITIONS**

Between the period 20 September 13.00 LHR - 30 September 10.00 LHR, Ryder Cup Europe LLP will pay for all transport; breakfast, lunch and evening meals; accommodation; for the European players' participation in the Junior Match at Olympia Fields Country Club, Chicago, Illinois, USA; 9-hole exhibition match at Medinah Country Club; and to watch the Ryder Cup at Medinah on 27 – 30 September.

All hotel and other incidentals, such as souvenirs, room service, excess baggage costs, etc. are to be paid for by the team members themselves. Each team member is expected to produce a credit/debit card details at hotel check-in to cover incidental costs.

Each Team member grants and assigns all individual media rights, now known or developed in the future, respecting participation in The 2012 Ryder Cup Junior Match, in perpetuity, inclusive of, but not limited to, television broadcasting, radio broadcasting, Internet cybercasting, highlight videos/movies and event specific rights to Ryder Cup Europe LLP and the PGA of America.

Team members are required to attend and participate in any and all special activities of a civic or social nature, which are arranged by Ryder Cup Europe LLP and the PGA of America in connection with the event.

Stuart Wilson has been selected as the Team Captain by European Golf Association and Ryder Cup Europe LLP. He has the sole and final authority with respect to all matters, relating to playing activities of the Team members of Ryder Cup Junior Match, the practice rounds and any special events, which take place in connection with The Ryder Cup Junior Match.

In this capacity, the Captain of the Team will assign members of the Team to compete in the event based upon his sole judgment and discretion.

Ryder Cup Europe LLP will provide each Team member with team uniform. Members are required to wear the established uniform during play and at any designated functions that are held in conjunction with the event. Team members will wear their national golf federation's formal dress for certain functions.

Team members will abide by the enclosed Code of Conduct

Parents and family members are to conduct themselves and represent Europe and their home nation in a first class and proper manner. Any conduct unbecoming or unsportsmanlike of an official or family member will be dealt with promptly and at the discretion of Ryder Cup Europe LLP.



# CODE OF CONDUCT TEAM MEMBERS

# **Principles of Participation**

## 1. Fair Play

Treat others with the same respect and fairness that you would like them to show you. Demonstrate 'Fair Play' on and off the course.

### 2. Equity

Respect the differences in gender, disability, culture, race, ethnicity, and religious belief systems between yourself and others.

Challenge discrimination and prejudice.

#### 3. Inclusiveness & Tolerance

Appreciate that all participants bring something valuable and different to the event.

Value and learn from the diversity of people you meet and show patience with others and act with dignity at all times.

#### 4. Responsibility

Look out for yourself and the welfare of others. Do not engage in any irresponsible or illegal behaviour.

Challenge behaviour that falls below the expected standards of the event. Speak out if you are concerned about anything or if you feel uncomfortable about your own needs and those of others. Be organised and on time.

#### 5. Friendship

Take time to thank those who help you take part – whether family, organisation or team mates.

## Conduct

- **1. Behaviour and Personal Conduct** must at all times be of a high standard and reflect favourably on the sport. Language in public or relevant group situations must always be appropriate and socially acceptable to all.
- **2. Consumption of alcohol and smoking** is forbidden. This includes whilst en-route, during the event and associated social activities.
- **3. Personal appearance** shall be appropriate to the circumstances and as indicated by the Junior Ryder Cup Captain. Team uniform and equipment issued shall be worn when assembling or travelling, during practice and matches; and at official team functions as directed by the Junior Ryder Cup Captain.
- **4. Attendance** at all activities is expected unless agreed by the Junior Ryder Cup Captain and the Match Manager. Throughout the duration of the events Team members should inform the Event staff of their whereabouts. Punctuality on all occasions is essential and any curfew must be observed.
- 5. Illegal and Performance Enhancing Drugs & Substances are forbidden.
- **6. Sexual activity** between young people is prohibited at the Event. Sexual relationships between adults and children under the age of 16 are illegal. Sexual activity between adults and young people over the age of 16 is prohibited when the adult is in a position of authority, e.g. coach, official, Event staff, etc.
- **7. Accommodation** at the hotels is directed by the Junior Ryder Cup Captain, and Match Manager on guidance from the Lead Child Protection Officer, at no time must anyone extra be accommodated in Team members' rooms.
- **8.** Breaches of the Code of Conduct and its principles shall be dealt with in the first instance by the Junior Ryder Cup Captain. He shall report the incident to the appropriate governing body who shall take such further action as is deemed necessary. All illegal or criminal behaviour will be investigated by the police/social services.

Disregard of the Code of Conduct could result in the Team member being immediately sent home.
